Due to the coronavirus pandemic, many may choose to vote absentee in this election, much like the primary election. If you would like to vote absentee you can apply for a ballot now at the Jefferson County Courthouse, or on [IndianaVoters.com](https://www.IndianaVoters.com).

If you are to apply for an absentee ballot, the application must be turned in at the courthouse by October 22, even if mailed in.

Once ballots are received, they must be turned in no later than noon on November 3, 2020.

If you are currently not registered to vote you have until October 5, 2020, to register.
