I would recommend any advertising or “announcements” you make regarding trick or treat times that you remind residents of these things:

- If you are feeling ill please do not participate in any trick or treat activities
- If you have been in contact with someone who has tested positive in the previous 2 weeks of Halloween please do not participate in trick or treat activities
- Mask must be worn anytime social distancing cannot be achieved with those outside of your household
- Only pre packaged candy should be given out
- Wash and inspect any fruits that may have been received during trick or treat
- Anyone that may be at high risk of becoming ill should not participate in trick or treat activities
- Take along hand sanitizer and sanitize hands frequently while trick or treating
- Wash hand immediately upon arriving home from trick or treating
